Home Churches

We see Home Church gatherings happening in homes, coffee shops, workplace lunch meetings, Hall of residence etc.

This will initially start out every 2 weeks on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month and during the week as well.

Home Church is where, out of love for one another, we gather to: break bread, pray, teach, share lives, expect signs and wonders. Eating together will be an important element.

Discipleship Groups

We see gathering of 3-4 people within a Home Church or Cluster that make themselves accountable to each other and do life together at a much more intimate level. Praying and studying the bible together.

Cluster Groups

We see a few Home Churches coming together to form Cluster groups to facilitate missions and community development in an area.

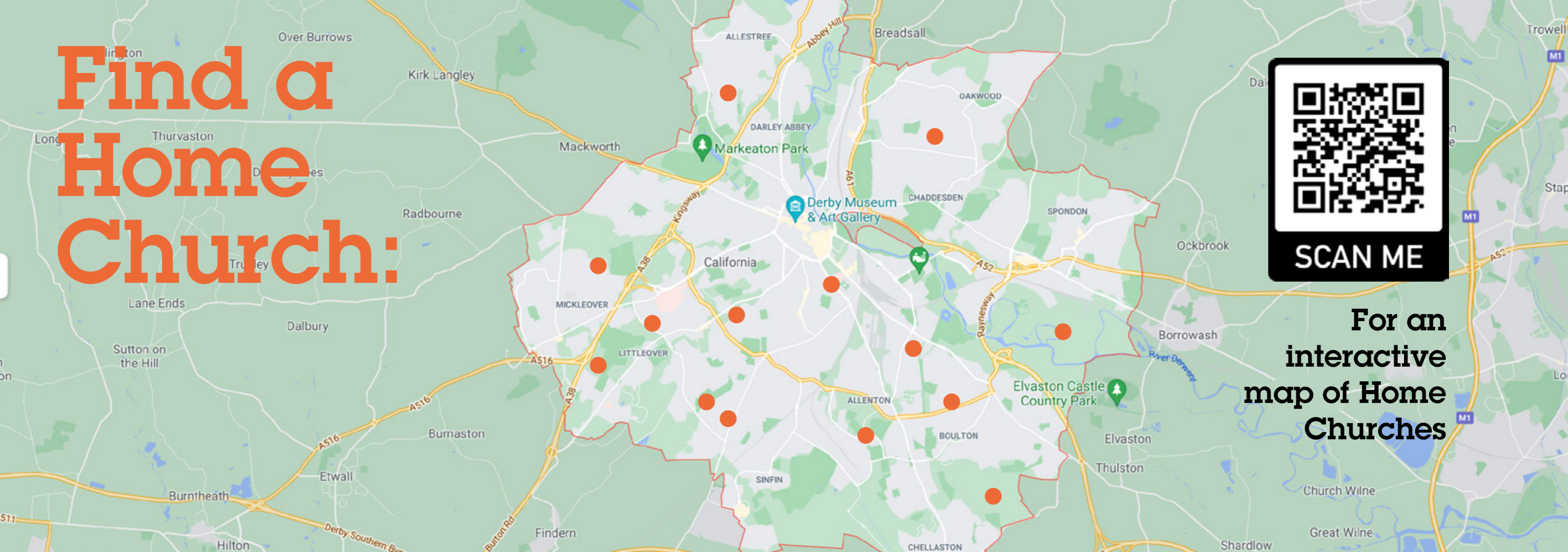
Celebration Gathering
